

Repeat Step 6. Every unit of prayer consists of two prostrations. Thus, step 7 is only in between two prostrations.

Note: Steps 2–8 = one Rak'ah. Repeat for the required number of units.

➤ **Step 9: Tashahhud (After 2 Rak'ah's)**

Sit as mentioned in step 7. Recite the following:

<p>Attahiyat lillahi wa salawatu wa't-tayyibat, as-salamu 'alayka ayyuha'n-Nabiyyu wa rahmat-Allahi wa barakatuhu. As-salamu 'alayna wa 'alaa 'ibad-illah is-saliheen. ashhadu alla ilaha illallah wa ashhadu anna muhammadan 'abduhu wa rasuluhu</p>	<p>All the best compliments, the prayers, and the good things are for Allah. Peace and Allah's Mercy and Blessings be on you, O Prophet! Peace be on us and on the pious slaves of Allah, I testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah, I also testify that Muhammad is Allah's slave and His Apostle</p>

Note: If you are praying 3 or 4 units of prayer, you must finish the remaining units of prayer repeating steps 2-9. If you are praying, only 2 units of prayer then proceed to the next step.

➤ **Step 10: Final Tashahhud**

After the last Rak'ah, recite the *tashahhud* (see step 9) again and then recite the following afterwards:

<p>Allahumma salli 'ala Muhammadin Wa 'ala ali Muhammadin Kama sallaita 'ala Ibrahim wa 'ala ali Ibrahim Innaka hamidun Majid. Allahumma barik 'ala Muhammadin wa 'ala ali Muhammadin Kama barakta 'ala Ibrahim Wa 'ala ali Ibrahim Innaka hamidun Majid.</p>	<p>O Allah let Your mercy come upon Muhammad and the family of Muhammad as You let it come upon Ibrahim and the family of Ibrahim O Allah bless Muhammad and the family of Muhammad as You blessed Ibrahim and the family of Ibrahim. Truly, You are Praiseworthy and Glorious.</p>

Step 11: Supplication (Optional)

One may supplicate to Allah for anything pertaining to the wellbeing of the hereafter. One universal supplication one may recite is the following:

<p>Rabbana Aatinaa Fiddunya Hasanatan Wa Fil Akhirati Hasanatan Wa Qina Adhaabannar</p>	<p>Our Lord! Give us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and defend us from the torment of the Fire</p>

Step 12: Ending the Prayer (Taslim)

Turn your head to the right once and then to the left once and recite the following while turning your head to each side:


Assalamu alaikum wa rahmatullah
 Peace and mercy of Allah be upon you

SALAT AL-JANAZA (Funeral Prayer)	
The Janazah prayer has neither Adhaan nor Iqamah The Janazah prayer is performed with one standing only and has neither bows (Ruku) nor prostration (Sujood). Follow the conditions of the prayer	
Steps to Be Followed:	
There are four Takbir in Salat Al-Janazah	
THE FIRST TAKBIR	
The Imam leading the Janazah prayer will recite the first Takbir out loud (Allahu Akbar - Allah is the Greatest)	
Follow the Imam and raise your hands up to the ears or shoulders and place them just like you would do in the normal five daily prayers	
Surah Al-Fatiha (Opening Chapter) - Recite this silently Verses/Surah from Quran or Thana - Recite this silently	
THE SECOND TAKBIR	
The Imam leading the Janazah prayer will recite the second Takbir out loud (i.e. Allahu Akbar - Allah is the Greatest) You can either choose to raise your hands again up to your earlobes or leave them as is, send blessings upon the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) as one does at the end of the prayer. Please see above.	
THE THIRD TAKBIR	
The Imam leading the Janazah prayer will recite the third takbir aloud. (i.e. Allahu Akbar - Allah is the Greatest) After saying the Takbir, Supplicate (Du'a) for the deceased. Below is one dua from the Sunnah, which the Prophet (peace be upon him) would pray for the deceased.	
<p>Allahummagh-fir lihayyina wamayyitina washahidina, wagha-ibina, wasagheerina wakabeerina, wathakarina wa-oong-saana. Allahumma man ahyaytahu minna fa-ahyih alal-islam, waman tawaffaytahu minna fatawaffahu alal-eeman, allahumma la tahrinma ajrah, wala tudillana ba'dah</p>	<p>O Allah forgive our living and our dead, those who are with us and those who are absent our young and our old, Our menfolk and our womenfolk. O Allah, whomever you give life from among us give him life in Islam, Whomever you take away from us, take him away in Faith. O Allah, do not forbid us their reward And do not send us astray after them</p>
THE FOURTH TAKBIR	
The Imam leading the Janazah prayer will say the fourth and final Takbir aloud. After saying the Takbir, The Imam will conclude the Janazah prayer by turning his head to the right and saying the Taslim. Follow the Imam and turn your head to the right and say	
<p>Assalamu alaikum wa rahmatullah Peace and mercy of Allah be upon you</p>	
<p>Doing it on both sides as in regular prayer is also ok</p>

Conditions of Prayer

- **Purification (Taharah)** - two types
 - **Physical:** Remove any impurity such as urine, stool, blood or alcohol from one's body, clothes, or place of prayer.
 - **Ritual:** Perform Wudu (Ablution):
 - 1) Make intention 2) washing one's face including rinsing the mouth and nose 3) washing the hands and arms including the elbows 4) wiping the head and ears both inside and out 5) washing the feet including the in between the toes and up to the ankles 5) doing so in order and 7) doing it continuously.
- **Covering (Awrah)**
 - **Men:** navel to under the knees.
 - **Women:** whole body including the head except the face and hands with loose fitted clothing.
- **Timing**
 - Pray only within its proper time. See Prayer timings chart. ①

- **Direction (Qiblah)**
 - Face the Ka'bah in Makkah. One may use any instrument that points out the direction.
- **Intention (Niyyah)**
 - Intend in your heart which prayer you are praying (e.g., Fajr, Zuhr).
 - Assure you are only doing it for Allah.

Prayer / Timings & obligatory Rak'ah

Prayer	Time Range	Rak'ah
Fajr	At Dawn → At Sunrise	2
Zuhr	After midday (zenith) → When object's shadow = its length (i.e. Asr time)	4
Asr	When object's shadow = its length → After Sun has set	4
Maghrib	After Sun has set → Red Twilight fades (i.e. Isha time starts)	3
Isha	Red Twilight fades → the true middle of the night	4

How to Pray

- **Step 1: Enter Prayer**
Raise both hands to shoulder level and recite **Allahu Akbar** (Allah is Greater). This is called Takbir, and this wording will repeat throughout the prayer. You are now in prayer.
- **Step 2: Standing**
Place your hands on your chest by grabbing your left wrist with your right hand. One should not talk, look or move around. Look at the place of prostration.
- **Step 3: Recitation**
- **Dua al-Istiftah (Opening Supplication - Thana)**
- **Seeking Refuge by saying**
A'udhu billahi min ash-shaytaan-ir-rajeem
I seek refuge with Allah from the accursed Satan
- **Surah Al-Fatiha (Opening Chapter)**
- **Verses/Surah from Quran**

Dua al-Istiftah (Opening Supplication - Thana)	
Subhaanaka Allaahumma wa bihamdika, wa tabaarakasmuka, wa ta'aalaa jadduka, wa laa 'ilaaha ghayruka.	Glorious You are O Allah- and with Your praise and blessed is Your Name - and exalted is Your majesty- and none has the right to be worshipped but You
Surah Al-Fatiha (Opening Chapter)

- **Step 4: Bowing (Rukū')**
Bow down reciting the **Takbir** (see step 1), bending only at your back, placing your hands on your knees and holding them. Once in this position recite X 3 times.

Subhana Rabbiyal Adhim
Glory be to my Lord, the Exalted

- **Step 5: Rise from Bowing position reciting:**
Sami'Allahu liman hamidah
Allah hears those who praise Him

And when you are standing upright recite

Rabbana lakal hamd
Our lord, to you be the praise.

- **Step 6: Prostration (Sujūd)**
Recite **Allahu Akbar** and go into prostration. Seven body parts touch the ground: face (forehead & nose), two palms, two knees, and toes of both feet.
Recite the following three times in this position:

Subhana Rabbiyal A'la
Glory is to my Lord, the Most High

- **Step 7: Sitting Between Two Prostrations**
Recite **Allahu Akbar** and sit on the left foot while the right foot is upright. Place your hands on your knees, and recite Dua

Rabbighfir li, Rabbighfir li
My Lord, forgive me. My Lord, forgive me

- **Step 8: Second Prostration** ③
